- Concerns were raised regarding village-wide drainage capacity and the increasing pressure from new developments. It was noted that Cllr Caruana has written to Yorkshire Water regarding drainage issues affecting the village as a whole.

I think the PC is well balanced now with the new members that have joined this year and I think we work well together.

Projects completed over the last year:

- New VAS sign on New Road
- Agreement reached with NYC to reduce the speed on Busk Lane around the airport to 30mph although the legal process needs to take place prior to installation
- Conducted a resident consultation and activities following the feedback is being prepared/considered
- Arranged a meeting of all village groups to improve communication and working together
- Improvements at Garys Garden
- Supported the setting up of a Wildlife group
- Brought the flood group under the Parish Council and allocated the group a budget for the coming year
- Arranged the installation of the speed buffer on New Road
- Installed gateways on all village entrances
